

TAKING THE LEAD: FORD DRIVING SKILLS FOR LIFE
“FREE SCHOOL ASSEMBLY” CONTEST RULES

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.
THE CONTEST IS VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.

1. How to Enter the Contest:

- (a) The Taking the Lead: Ford Driving Skills For Life “Free School Assembly” contest has been ongoing since Monday, 10/11/10 @ 5A and will end on Sunday, 5/2/11 @ 12M for the assembly drawing and 6/2/11 for the school grant award. Contest is sponsored by Ford Motor Co Fund, Westfield Insurance and Allegheny County Pretrial Services.
- (b) Schools that have previously registered are also eligible. To participate in the contest, log onto www.CBSPittsburgh.com/safedrivers and register your school’s information on the on-line entry form.
- (c) One entry per person. Must be at least 16 years of age to enter a school nomination.
- (d) Sponsor is not responsible for technical or computer failures, errors or data loss of any kind, lost or unavailable Internet connections, or failed, incomplete, garbled or deleted computer or network transmissions, inability to access any Web site or on-line service, or any other error or malfunction, or late, lost, illegible or misdirected entries. Entry materials that have been tampered with or altered are void. If the judges determine, in their sole discretion, that there is any suspected or actual electronic tampering with the Contest or if technical difficulties compromise the integrity of the Contest, the judges reserve the right to void the entries at issue and/or terminate the Contest and conduct a random drawing to award the prize among all eligible entries received as of the termination date. If the Contest is terminated due to tampering or technical difficulties prior to its expiration date, notice will be posted at www.CBSPittsburgh.com. If, for any reason, the Contest is not capable of running as planned, including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes beyond the control of Sponsor which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Contest, Sponsor reserves the right at its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Contest. Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any entrant that tampers with the operation of the Contest or website or violates the Official Rules of the Contest.

- (e) Broadcasts are subject to preemptions and scheduling changes. If such changes occur they will be posted on the www.kdka.com (Station) website.
- (f) Entry deemed made by holder of e-mail account.
- (g) Odds of winning depend on number of eligible entries.

2. Eligibility Restrictions:

- (a) The contest is open to Pennsylvania, West Virginia and Ohio residents who are 16 years of age or older. Employees of KDKA-TV, CBS Corporation, the Ford Motor Co. Fund, Ford Motor Company, Westfield Insurance, Westfield Insurance Foundation, Allegheny County Pretrial Services and the Governors Highway Safety Association, other television and radio stations in the Pennsylvania market, and their affiliates, subsidiaries and advertising agencies and their immediate family members and persons living in the same household are ineligible to participate or win.
- (b) Viewers are eligible to win a KDKA-TV contest only once every sixty days. Only one winner per household is permitted in any contest. Viewers are eligible to win a prize valued at \$600.00 or more only once every six months.
- (c) All entries become the sole property of Station and will not be returned. By entering, entrants agree to abide by these rules, and warrant and represent that their entry is their original work.
- (d) Contestants are required to provide truthful information and the Station will reject and delete any entry that it discovers to be false or fraudulent. The Station will disqualify any entry from individuals who do not meet the eligibility requirements, and the Station will also delete any entry received from persons under the age of 13.

3. Prizes:

- (a) Each month for the duration of the contest, one school will be randomly selected from all registrations submitted on www.CBSPittsburgh.com for a monthly assembly during the 2010/11 school year. The monthly school winner will receive a one-hour free assembly hosted and conducted by representatives from KDKA-TV, the Ford Motor Co., Westfield Insurance and Allegheny County Pretrial Services. The assembly will cover the safe driving skills and education material for newly licensed drivers based on the "Ford Driving Skills For Life" program.

- (b) At the end of the 2010/2011 school year, one of the schools that had the assembly program presented to the students will be selected to receive a \$3,000 grant provided by Westfield Insurance. The selection will be based on the school with the highest percentage of on-line participation by students to the designated URL for grant contest (www.westfieldinsurance.com/takingthelead) by the deadline date of 6/2/11. Each school's percentage is based on the on-line participation compared to the number of students that attended the school assembly. Winning school for the grant award will be determined in June 2011 (with the last school assembly taking place in May'11).
- (c) Deadline for entering for the monthly school assembly program is 5/2/11 at 12 Midnight. Deadline for students that have already seen the monthly school assembly at their high school during the 2010/11 school year to register to win the school grant is 6/2/11. One school will be randomly selected each month (beginning the week of 10/18/10) to have the free assembly program come to their school and the school Principals will be notified by phone/email to coordinate assembly. School with the most "on-line participation percentage" following their individual school assembly will be announced the week of 6/6/11.
- (d) All prizes or prize certificates may be picked up at the office of KDKA-TV; One Gateway Center, Pittsburgh, PA 15222. Any assembly confirmation (prize) not claimed within two (2) days of winning will be forfeited by the winner.
- (e) Contest prizes are not transferable. Prizes may not be substituted for or redeemed for cash. Station reserves the right to substitute prize of comparable value.

4. Selection of Winners:

- (a) Decisions of contest sponsors with respect to the contest are final.
- (b) Winning schools for the free monthly school assembly will be randomly selected from all eligible entries received at CBSPittsburgh.com throughout the contest dates.
- (c) One grant award will be announced the week of 6/6/11 for the one high school visited during the 2010/11 school year. The selection will be based on the school with the highest percentage of on-line participation to the designated URL for grant contest (www.westfieldinsurance.com/takingthelead). Each school's percentage is based on the on-line student participation following their assembly compared to the number of students that attended their individual school assembly.

5. Conditions:

- (a) Payment of all federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner and winners may receive an IRS Form 1099 or equivalent from Station.
 - (b) By participating in the contest, the winners agree to have their name, voice, or likeness used in any advertising or broadcasting material relating to this contest, and to sign a publicity release, affidavit of eligibility and release of liability prior to acceptance of the prize. By accepting the prize, each winner grants to Station the right to use the winner's name, voice, picture and/or likeness for purposes of advertising and publicity in any and all media now known or hereafter invented, without further permission or additional compensation (except where prohibited by law). All expenses on receipt and use of prize are the sole responsibility of winner.
